Discussion Questions

1. Read Romans 3:21-24. What does this passage say about our relationship with God?
2. Why do you think this is difficult for people to accept?
3. What challenged you most from Sunday's message? Why?
4. Righteousness, simply described, refers to the result of being made "right" or accepted by God. Since this is not earned or due to us on basis of our effort, how does this impact our understanding of acceptance by God? And our acceptance of others?
5. Read 1 John 4:19 and Romans 15:7. If we respond to his invitation, what effect is that meant to have on us?
6. Why can it be difficult to accept others the way Christ has accepted us?
7. How can acceptance and belonging change the dynamic of the relationship?

8. What happens when we accept others for who they are without preconditions?

9. If you follow Jesus, what prompted you to respond to the message of Romans 3:21-24?

10. Where do you need to see Sunday's message take root in your life?

11. How will you begin the process of growing in this area?
