3. What would you say is the difference between knowledge and wisdom?
4. Read Proverbs 3:13-18. What stands out to you from this passage, and why? Is there anything that surprises or confuses you about it?
5. The passage suggests that those who find wisdom find life and receive favor from the Lord. How does wisdom contribute to a fulfilling and blessed life according to these verses?
6. In the context of these verses, how does the fear of the Lord connect with the acquisition of wisdom? What role does reverence for God play in the pursuit of wisdom?
7. Jesus' arrival epitomized the way of wisdom. Read James 3:13-18. How does the passage define and differentiate between heavenly wisdom and earthly wisdom?
8. The passage suggests that wisdom leads to a harvest of righteousness. What does this metaphor imply about the long-term effects and outcomes of living a wise and righteous life?
9. What are some things that can help us grow in wisdom?
10. Looking back over 2023, are there areas you can identify where you lacked wisdom? Or rejected someone's wise counsel?
11. In what areas do you foresee needing wisdom in 2024? Take time as a group to pray about those areas.
