What's DC's favorite question? "So... what do you do?"

- My job defines me
- Comparison exhausts me
- Disagreement threatens me
- Falling behind terrifies me

How does self-worth become healthy?

John 6:63(NIV): "The words I have spoken to you are full of the Spirit and life."

John 1:1-5, 12(NIV): "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. 2 He was with God in the beginning. 3 Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made. 4 In him was life, and that life was the light of all mankind. 5 The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.... to all who did receive him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God."

Genesis 1:1(NIV): "In the beginning"

The Ancient Near East is where humanity first developed:

- agriculture
- cities
- writing
- law codes
- political theology
- creation stories

People were asking the biggest questions:

- Why are we here?
- Who has power?
- How does life work?
- What gives humans value?

The most famous creation story was the Enuma Elish.

- chaos is solved by violence
- the gods fight
- creation comes from death
- humans are created as slaves
- worth comes from usefulness
- fear keeps society stable

Genesis does not copy that story.
Genesis confronts it.

Genesis says:

- chaos is healed by words
- God speaks, not kills
- humans are image-bearers, not slaves
- worth is given, not earned

Genesis 1:3(NIV): "Let there be light."

John 1:5(NIV): "The light shines in the darkness."

Light isn't morality. It's reality.

John 1:12(NIV): "To all who received him... he gave the right to become children of God."

- Receive = accept what is real
- Right = permission to see yourself correctly
- Become = begin living from that truth
