7. Look at the broader context of the word "faith" in Colossians 1:1-8, what do you think Paul emphasizes—knowledge or action? Why? (Read also James 2:14-26)
8. Colossians 1:2 identifies those in Colosse as "faithful". What does being faithful to Jesus' teachings and the gospel look like?
9. Why is obedience, faithfulness, a distinguishing mark of true faith? (Consider John 15:1-10)
10. Paul said the gospel will bear fruit where it takes root. What are some of the most vivid evidences of life change that God has produced in you since starting your journey of faith?
11. What do you feel resonates or challenges you most from this week's discussion? Why?
12. What is one thing you want to take away and see change because of this week's message, scripture and discussion?
