### Discussion Questions

4. Paul states that we now "live a new life". What does this new life look like? (Consider Romans 6:20-23)
5. Do you feel any tension between the former way of living and the new way of living that Paul talks about?
6. If those who follow Jesus have "died to sin", why do you think Paul commands action on our part when it comes to sin (Romans 6:12-13; Galatians 2:20 and Galatians 5:24-25)?
7. There is a shift that takes place in Romans 6:13, from sin to life. How does this positive purpose affect your focus and your progress? (Cf. Romans 6:17; Philippians 3:12-14)
8. What positive purpose or spiritual focus do you feel challenged to take up this week that will help you step beyond the influence of sin?
