- 5. What stood out to you from Sunday's message? Why?
- 6. Read Isaiah 2:3. To whom was the text given? Why does this matter when it comes to reading the text? (There is a parallel verse in Micah 4:2)
- 7. What things should be considered when reading something that was not written specifically to us?
- 8. Pastor John mentioned how the Hebrew culture had a different focus than Greek culture. What were some of the differences he mentioned?
- 9. What would it mean to "read the Bible the way it was written"?
- 10. Take a few moments to voice the questions you might have about the Bible. This may not be the time to offer answers, but a great time to raise questions. Have someone in the group write them down.
- 11. Over the coming weeks, Grace will be studying the book of Genesis in greater detail. This week, take a few minutes to read Genesis 1-11 taking note of times where God's words or actions surprise you.
