1. What were the main points of Sunday's message?
2. Which main point stood out to you most? Why?
3. Read Genesis 9:1-17. What parallels do you see between the covenant with Noah and the story of creation in Genesis 1-2? What is different?
4. What comes to mind when you think of a covenant?
5. Notice that God makes some big promises in Genesis 9 but asks for nothing in return? Why is this unique? What does this tell us about God's purposes to save all creation?
6. Read 2 Corinthians 5:14-21. What differences are there between Jesus' followers in this passage and the violence and anger of humanity?
7. How does Paul describe God partnering with humanity to heal humanity in this passage?
8. Do you think it's significant that God chooses to partner with humanity to heal humanity? Why or why not?
9. Second Corinthians 5:16 says, "we regard no one from a human point of view". What could this mean and how might it impact how we treat others? (Pastor John developed this through the story of the Good Samaritan in Luke 10:25-37)
10. What makes it difficult to see the image of God in others?
11. To what extent do you see the image of God in other people? How could doing so be the cure for your relationships and your community?
12. Based on Sunday's message and these texts, what action or response do you feel God calling you to take?
