2. What do you feel comes most naturally or least naturally to you—give, serve or love? Why?
3. Read John 13:1-17. What stands out to you from Jesus' words to his disciples? Why does that stand out?
4. What do you think left the biggest impact on Jesus' disciples?
5. Why do you think Jesus chose to demonstrate this principle through washing feet?
6. Read Romans 12:3-10. In these verses, Paul describes the followers of Jesus as "the Body of Christ". How do these verses reinforce and further explain Jesus' teaching in John 13:1-7?
7. Despite everyone's differences, Romans 12 seems to communicate that we are all equal. What is the thing that makes us all equal in the sight of God?
8. How do these two passages speak to the fact that love functions best when we see each other as equal?
9. Derek stated, "The enemy of love is pride. Pride is self-centered, love is other-centered. You can love anyone if you believe that person is not beneath you." Where do you find it most challenging to see others as equal?
10. What types of different personalities or backgrounds do you find most difficult to love and serve as Jesus describes?
