### Discussion Questions

1. Read Romans 12:1-2. What speaks to you from this passage?
2. Write down three things that stood out to you from this week's message. Why did these things resonate with you?
3. Why is the image and character of Jack so intriguing *and* challenging?
4. Philippians 2:1-8. What parallels do you see between the character of Jack, the life of Jesus and what Jesus calls his followers to?
5. Select two of the character traits or challenges from this passage in Philippians and identify ways these would practically impact your relationship with God and others.
6. Romans 12:2 and Philippians 2:5 talk about being transformed—having a mind that reflects that of Jesus. How does this begin to take place? What things help us grow in this area?

7. Romans 12 and Philippians 2 can be boiled down to becoming “like Christ”. How does the self-sacrificing and selfless nature of Christ change how we approach relationships?
8. Jack states that his family and wife have become his purpose. Romans 12 and Philippians 2 talk about our purpose being one of reflecting Jesus. How does this purpose give direction to understanding God’s will for our life and relationships?
9. What areas do you see selfishness getting in the way of growing and healthy relationships? What about your relationship with God?
