- 1. Read Ephesians 1:15-20. What stands out to you from Paul's prayer for Jesus' followers in Ephesus? Why?
- 2. What things sound like a priority for Paul in this passage?
- 3. What impact does the wisdom and revelation of God have on Jesus' followers?
- 4. Does Paul's prayer help give clarity to how we should live? How so?
- 5. In the beginning of Abraham's story, he is constantly taking. In Genesis 20:16, he changes from selfish love to sacrificial love. Take a few minutes to discuss the differences between these two types of love? What do they practically look like?
- 6. Can you have love without it being in some sense selfish? Why or why not?
- 7. Sacrificial love, as the greatest love, stands as one of the main priorities of the Bible. Why do you think the Bible focuses so strongly on that?
- 8. Read John 15:12-16 and 1 John 3:16. What do you think it means that Jesus would lay down his life for you?
- 9. Sacrificial love costs something, can you identify something that loving someone might cost you?
- 10. How does the theme of sacrificial love help bring clarity to the Bible? Or your understanding of Christianity?
- 11. Does sacrificial love help bring any clarity to your life? If so, how?
- 12. How will you respond to this week's message and biblical passages?
