Ephesians 3:14-21(NIV): For this reason, I kneel before the Father, from whom every family in heaven and on earth derives its name. I pray that out of his glorious riches he may strengthen you with power through his Spirit in your inner being, so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith. And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, may have power, together with all the Lord's holy people, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, 19 and to know this love that surpasses knowledge—that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God. In Our World, Love is a Zero-Sum Game

Isaac is LOVED. Ishmael is REJECTED Jacob is LOVED. Esau is REJECTED

Deuteronomy 33:1-3(NLT): "This is the blessing that Moses, the man of God, gave to the people of Israel before his death: The Lord came from Mount Sinai(Isaac & Jacob) and dawned upon us from Mount Seir(Esau); He shone forth from Mount Paran(Ishmael)... Indeed, He loves his people..."

In God's World, Love ISN'T a Zero-Sum Game

Secure Attachment: Healthy, Confident, secure, open to love, trust, and deep connection.

Anxious Attachment: Fear, Anxious, insecure, overthink everything, emotionally drained.

Avoidant Attachment: Isolated, Withdrawn, avoid meaningful relationships—missing out on true happiness.

Disorganized Attachment: Chaotic, Life feels like an emotional roller coaster, marked by stress & instability.

Secure Attachment requires: unconditional love and emotional attunement

Galatians 5:13, 14(MSG): "It is absolutely clear that God has called you to a free life. Just make sure that you don't use this freedom as an excuse to do whatever you want to do and destroy your freedom. Rather, use your freedom to serve one another in love; that's how freedom grows. For everything we know about God's Word is summed up in a single sentence: Love others as you love yourself. That's an act of true freedom."

Anomie- Fmile Durkheim

Hyper- Individualism(everyone is free to be anything they want)

Judges 21:25(NLT): "...all the people did whatever seemed right in their own eyes."

Plagued by an identity crisis Suffer from major swings in polarized extremes Rapid increase in depression, loneliness, and suicide Meaning replaced by materialism

A Healthy Secure Attachment is characterized by both:

Independence- I am loved for who I am

Interdependence- I love by being emotionally attuned to who you are
