

Aligned And Alive: Finding Power in God's Character

Isaiah 40:29(LEB): "He gives power to the weary, and he increases power for the powerless."

Judges 4:1(CEB): "After Ehud had died, the Israelites again did things that the Lord saw as evil."

God knows you better than you know yourself

Judges 4:1-6(CEB): After Ehud had died, the Israelites again did things that the Lord saw as evil. 2 So the Lord gave them over to King Jabin of Canaan, who reigned in Hazor. The commander of his army was Sisera, and he was stationed in Harosheth-ha-goilm. ³ The Israelites cried out to the Lord because Sisera had nine hundred iron chariots and had oppressed the Israelites cruelly for twenty years. ⁴ Now Deborah, a prophet, the wife of Lappidoth, was a leader of Israel at that time. ⁵ She would sit under Deborah's palm tree between Ramah and Bethel in the Ephraim highlands, and the Israelites would come to her to settle disputes. ⁶ She sent word to Barak, Abinoam's son, from Kedesh in Naphtali and said to him, 'Hasn't the Lord, Israel's God, issued you a command?"

Psalm 20:7(NIV): "Some trust in chariots and some in horses, but we trust in the name of the Lord our God."

In English, obey means to comply — to do what you're told, usually out of duty or fear.

In Hebrew, shema means to connect — to pause, listen deeply, reflect, and then act out of understanding.

Command (מְצְוַה / Mitzvah) Today: Control + Consequences Ancient Hebrew: Alignment + Fulfillment

The more aligned you are with God, the more alive you become

YOU can't suppress your desires — YOU have to replace your desires

Suppression fails.
Replacement transforms.
Replace your desires with God's character.

Compassion — alleviating suffering. Grace — lifting others up. Patience — being slow to anger.

Start your day REACHING for God's character. End your day REFLECTING on it. Reach. Reflect. Rewire. This is how you become fully alive.
