- 7. Where does, or to whom does, Jesus model devotion? What are some of the characteristics of his devotion?
- 8. Are there certain things that cause you to question someone's devotion? How do you recover from those moments?
- 9. 1 John 4:11-12, 19-20 states that we love because he loved us. The word used here reflects an unconditional, devoted love. What does devotion to Jesus look like?
- 10. What next step could you envision when you think of your devotion to God?
