8. How do you know when something takes the place of god? (consider Luke 16:10-15)
9. Matthew 19:26 is a very common passage within the Christian community. How does context inform the meaning of this passage?
10. How do we break free from the grip of money?
11. What would your life look like if Jesus had just a little more priority in your finances?
12. What small step do you need to take to give Jesus priority?
13. How can your group pray with you to see Jesus take a greater place of priority?
