- 8. John said, "When you get to the end of great faith, it's not God acting, it's us acting. Only genuine faith can cancel an unjust culture." Thoughts?
- 9. Read the Parable of the Good Samaritan (Luke 10:25-37). What does this parable tell us about what genuine faith looks like? Make a list of some of the qualities of genuine faith based on the story.
